On July 19th at 2110 myself and three collegues were airborne Leeds on "Midland Juliet Brayo" om our direct flight to Barcelona. 25 Minutes later we were landing at East Midlands to refuel and change crews. According to the tour brochure we were supposed to be flying to Geroma, but we received a letter stating that British Midland found Gerona unsuitable for night operations. We were later to discover that Gerona was in fact suitable for night operations and that Midland are about the only British airline that does not operate into Gerona at night.

Below is listed what was at Barcelona on our arrival and departure. A few words of explanation about the flyover report are required. The main airway runs right over Lloret de Mar where we were staying. To the North is Bagur. Aircraft going to land at Barcelona are routed via Sabadell just outside Barcelona.
