

R.A.F. NEPTUNES AT TOPCLIFFE.

In 1951 under MDAP, the U.S.A. procured some 60 P2V-5 Neptunes for use by the R.A.F. The majority of these were based at Topcliffe. These Neptunes were given the USAF serials 51-15914 to 51-15965 and some in the 51-15971 to 15989, and R.A.F. WX493 - WX529 and WX543 - WX562.

All aircraft were delivered in their USN "Midnite" Blue, some with USAF serials and some in full R.A.F. colours but all with R.A.F. roundels and fin flash. One of the 1453 Flt. m/c's 51-15945 code 3 retained its USAF serial for a while in service before becoming WX500.

The Neptunes were all delivered as P2V-5's and some were modified during service with MAD tails and internal mods to bring them up to a semi P2V-7 state, and at least one (WX562) had auxiliary jets.

After use all aircraft were stored at 22MU R.A.F. Silloth where some of them were refurbished and returned to the U.S.A. for re-allocation to the Argentine A.F. The remaining aircraft were then scrapped and some ended upon the dump at Droylesden and some center sections even found their way to Lasham in 1960.

R.A.F. Squadrons to use the Neptune at Topcliffe were :-

No 36 Sqn. formed at Topcliffe 5/53. Used the Sqn. code letter T on the rear fuselage in green, outlined in white, also the individual aircraft letter. This system of two letter coding was used until 1955 when the letter was replaced by the Sqn. no. i.e. 36. Unit disbanded 12/56.

No.203 Sqn. formed at Topcliffe 1/53. Code letter "B". In red outline on white till 1955 then "203". Squadron disbanded 12/56.

No.210 Sqn. formed at Topcliffe 1/53. Code letter "L" in red outline in white till 1955 then "210". Squadron disbanded 12/56.

No. 1453 Flight, operated at Topcliffe with Neptunes on classified duties. Individual nos, 1 to 4 were used instead of code or unit letters.

## NEWS

Two ex SCBS Hastings T.5's have been delivered to Castleside and Stansted for burning. TG518 was delivered to Carlisle for the airport fire service on 13.5.69 and TG529 was delivered to the MoA Fire School at Stansted on 24.5.69.

As briefly mentioned last month Cessna 337D G-AXGI was delivered to Northair on 9.6.69 from Brussels. Its c/n is 337D - 1095 and it is ex N86141. During March/April Northair purchased Cessna F.150G's G-AVGL(c/n 0157) and G-AVNC(c/n 0200) and soon after delivered them to the Portsmouth School of Flying. Neither came to Leeds. Once Cessna F.172H G-AXFK (c/n 0613) has been delivered Northair have no new aircraft on order.

Tees Side Air Charter Ltd. hopes to establish an airfield at Grindale, four miles from Bridlington by the end of September. The proposed site will have grass runways of 2,000 ft and 1,100 ft and also a hangar, control tower, and club house.

Bearle Airedale G-NTAV has been sold to Messrs. Beckett, Claybourn, and Dowell and they are to base it at Doncaster.

On Thursday 31st of July the last navy pilot of a fixed wing aircraft will receive his wings at the passing out parade of No. 142 Fixed Wing Course at Linton on Ouse. To mark the end of 1 F.T.S. 45 year association with Royal Navy pilot training there will be a fly past of 36 of today's Royal Navy aircraft, Phantoms, Buccaneers, Sea Vixens, and Gannets, the formation will be led by a Swordfish. Also there will be flying displays by individual Navy aircraft and by the Red Arrows.

In Leeds there has been an outbreak of Helicopter mania. Dysons Garage, Low Fields Road, nr. Leeds Utd. football ground have acquired Dragonfly WN500 (904). It is full Royal Navy colours and is less rotor blades. Wallace Arnolds of Hunslet Road Leeds have also acquired a Dragonfly this time WG707, it is painted in a metallic blue with the words Wallace Arnold Sales and Service Ltd written on port side. Leeds University have purchased a Skeeter for use of the Maths Dept but so far it has not been identified though it has been there some weeks, also we have had a report that a Leeds Company Director has a Dragonfly in his back garden, but other than that nothing.

The forthcoming Public Enquiry into the extension of the runway at Leeds/Bradford has been postponed till an unknown date ( to the Editor).

All Autair scheduled flights are to stop. Further details next month.

## Travellers Tales.

This subject in Yorkshire Air News is still short of articles. If you have visited an airfield anywhere in the world this year tell all your friends about it, they're just as interested as you are. We would prefer a written article but a straight list will be published if interesting enough.

A visit to Newcastle on 2.7.69 by Mr.T.Smith produced the following, G-ANBH Britannia, void of markings and in storage, this aircraft will probably not fly again, Cherokee G-AVYP was doing local flying, and Trident G-AVYD took 35mins. from passengers boarding to take off. Visiting aircraft at the time were Piaggio P.166 G-ASVM, Cessna 172 G-AVUL, Viscount G-AVJW, the southbound Scottish Flyer, and two King Airs, PH-ILK, and an unidentified red and white one, ( any offers? ).

On the 5th of July USAF Alconbury held a NATO Friendship day, among the visitors there was the Editor. In the static park were O-22678 a C-97C of the 7101st A.B.W., O-25805 a C-131A of the Airevac Rhein Main, O-52800 a 48th T.F.W. camouflaged F-100D, O-60102 an RF-101C of the 66th T.R.W., O-61241 an F-102A from 526th F.I.S. 3770/PB Hercules C-130E was in the static park for a while before leaving to drop parachutists in the display. Foreign aircraft that were statically displayed were an F-84 FU-106 of the Belgian Air Force in a much worn grey and green camouflage, MM6451 a brand new Fiat G91Y of the Italian Air Force, the first one the Editor has heard of in England, West German RF-104's 24+90, and 25+03 were also in the static park.

The flying display was well up to the usual USAF standard of being dull and uninteresting though it was livened up by Lightning XM214 and other British participants, and also by Belgian Air Force F-104's FX-15 and FX-20 which gave a good aerobatic display as did Fiat G91Y MM6443.
