Demonstrations were given by the four Beagle 206s of Northair, the three Yankee's of Eastern Aviation, the three Cessna 150s of the Yorkshire Aeroplane Club and Midland Aviation borrowed Northairs Cessna F150 G-AZLK to join their own Cessna F150 G-AVGM and the American registered Cessna F172 for their display. The Wallis Gyrocopter was displayed on the stand of the Northern Aircraft Preservation Society. Aerobatics were limited this year due to high winds and low cloud, Zlin G-AWSH provided the civil section with the Jet Provost XW370 and the Hunter and Lightning doing the solo's for the R.A.F. The U.S.A.F. did their usual one run down the runway and vanished so confirmation of any of the serials will be welcome.

NEWS

CATTERICK: The disbandment of 204 Sqdn. Honington, on the 28th April has meant that the Shackletons MR.2C have been arriving here for the fire school. Arrivals here during May have been, WL800/J; WG555/K; WL755/L; WL748/R and WL758/W, whilst WL750/H; WR961/U and WL738/Y are expected in the near future.

DISFORTH: Chipmunk WZ879/18 from 2F.T.S. was being used as glider tug on 13th May.

LINTON-ON-OUSE: Jet Provost T3. is thought to be XM349/68 and not XM346, the latter being on the fire dump at Thorney Island.

RUFFORTH: Condor G-AZMV is now resident here, being on lease to the Ouse Gliding Club as glider tug.

SHERBURN: Condor G-AVNV which was on loan to the Sherburn Aero Club has now departed and has been replaced by Condor G-AVZE, the Condor fleet still remains at four, G-AVZE, G-AWEI, G-AWSO and G-AXGT. Jodel DR1050 G-AYJA arrived here on 2.6. in part exchange for Horizon G-AZRX which was delivered to R. Compton at Blackpool the same day. The Yankee G-AZKS which overturned at Paull on 27.4, is now with Eastern Aviation for rebuild, and also with Eastern Aviation on 2.6. was Terrier G-AVCR of the RAFGSA which was undergoing maintenance. American Aviation AA-5 Traveler's G-AZUG (C/N 083) G-AZVE (C/N 074) and G-AZVG (C/N 075) were registered to Eastern Aviation in May, although the aircraft are still awaiting exportation from the U.S.A.

THOLTHORPE: Further to our report in April Y.A.N., Emeraude G-ASDW has now been completely rebuilt and now sports a red and white colour scheme.

On 15.5. Whirlwind XP404 landed at the Hull Royal Infirmary to deliver a patient from a ship in the North Sea.

Cameron Hot Air Balloon G-AYAM made an ascent at the Leeds Greyhound Stadium on the 20th May, however, due to fuel starvation the balloon made a forced landing some 23 miles later in trees at Bingley.

A Helicopter Meet at Castle Howard on the 27th May, was effected by the strong winds, with the result that Jet Ranger G-AYBE carrying the organiser was the only arrival.

Air Anglia have been granted a licence to open a new service between Norwich and Leeds/Bradford, which is thought to come into operation in November. There are optional stops at Birmingham and East Midlands.

The Leeds Gliding Club Slingsby T.31, BGAL012 crashed and was written-off at Pocklington on May 28th. The glider was being flown by a student pilot on his second solo, who apparently landed it too fast, upon touching down it spread itself over the runway.
